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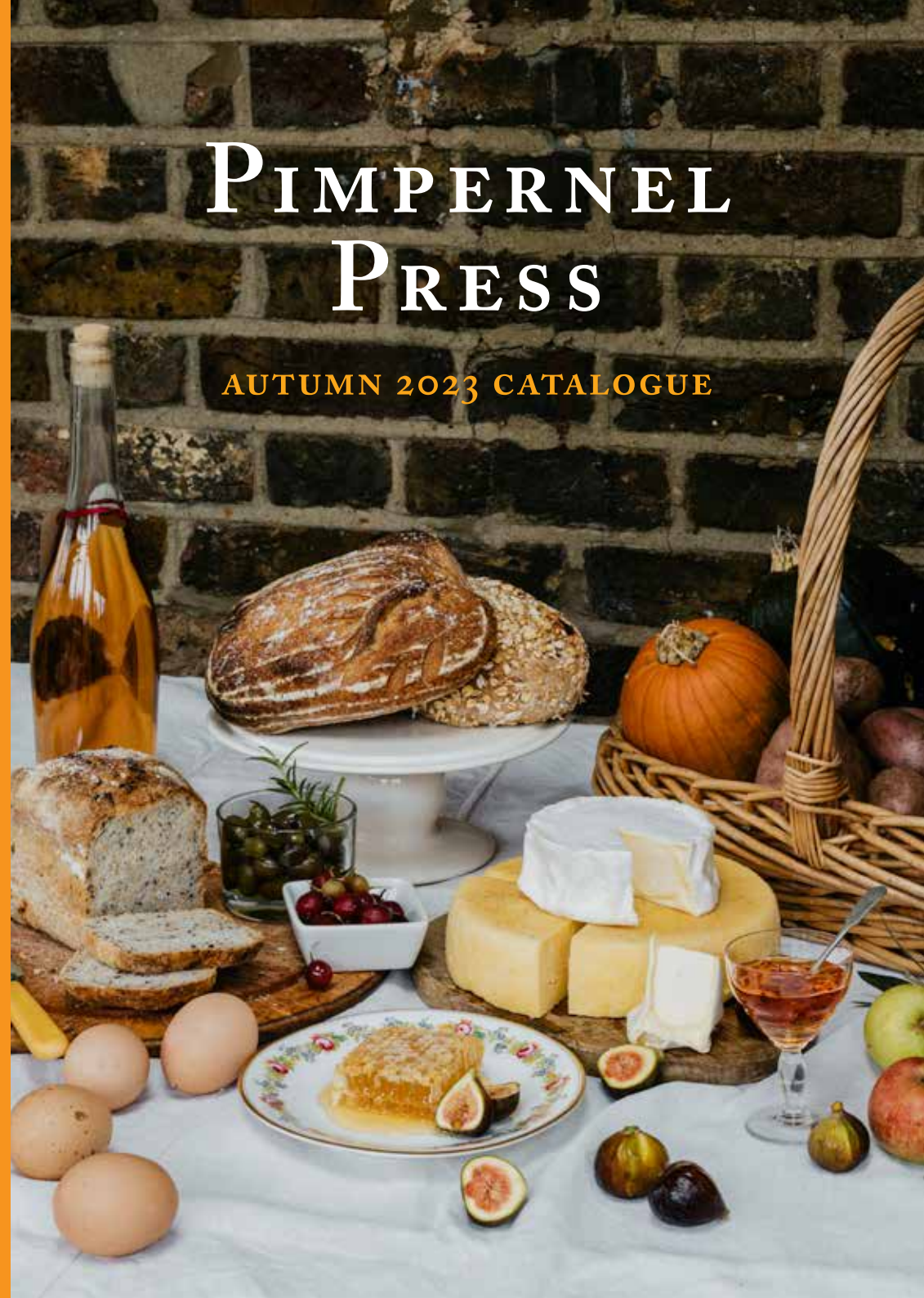

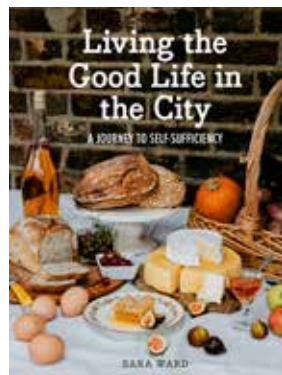

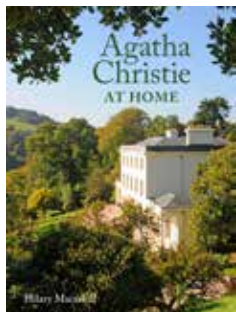

This new and revised edition of Hilary Macaskill's classic book, with many new illustrations, offers an insight into the life and work of the world's bestselling author.

Agatha Christie wrote in her autobiography, 'What I liked playing with as a child I have liked playing with later in life. Houses, for instance.' She also lovingly included descriptions of houses (especially 'her') houses in her books.

Hilary Macaskill looks at the houses that meant most to Agatha Christie, including her childhood home, Ashfield, in Torquay; Winterbrook in Oxfordshire, and, above all, Greenway, soaring above the River Dart and Agatha's favourite home from 1938 to the end of her life in 1976 (though requisitioned in the Second World War by the Admiralty, and from 1943 to 1945 home also to the United States Coast Guard).

The author also explores more temporary abodes, not only a succession of flats and houses in London (mainly in Kensington and Chelsea) but also the homes she set up at the digs (mostly in the Middle East) that she travelled to with her archaeologist husband, Max Mallowan, and the hotels – notably the Moorlands Hotel on Dartmoor, to which she adjourned in the grip of writer's block to complete her first detective novel, *The Mysterious Affair at Styles*, and the Burgh Island Hotel, a major inspiration for *And Then There Were None* and *Evil Under the Sun*.

Patthana is an award-winning village garden in Kiltegan, Co. Wicklow, Ireland, home for the past 20 years to artist TJ Maher and his partner. When they bought the property the garden was neglected and presented a blank canvas for artist TJ to create a beautiful, sustainable and wildlife-friendly garden – which he has done.

In *Grounding in the Garden*, his first book, TJ Maher explores the practical considerations which come into play when making a garden that combines horticultural and artistic excellence. He goes deep into such subjects as using colour, implementing designs and ideas, choosing the best plants for each season, supporting wildlife, and creating borders and pot displays. His occasional reflections on nature add an extra dimension.

The book, as well as being both practical and thought-provoking, is a visual feast: the beauty of the garden – its plants, animals and colour – is celebrated through both TJ's images and those of professional garden photographers Clive Nichols and Jason Ingram, and wildlife photographer Kieran Neary.



Born in the village of Golden in Co Tipperary, **TJ MAHER** studied at the Crawford School of Art in Cork and at the National College of Art and Design (NCAD) in Dublin. From the beginning his work attracted favourable attention and he has won many awards, including EVA International in Limerick. He is represented by the Taylor Galleries in Dublin, where many solo shows of his work have been held, the most recent, entitled *Annica*, in 2018. He has represented Ireland at the International Festival of Painting in Cagnes-sur-Mer, France.

JASON INGRAM is an award-winning photographer of gardens, plants, food and people.

CLIVE NICHOLS has photographed many of the world's best gardens and his work has appeared in hundreds of books.

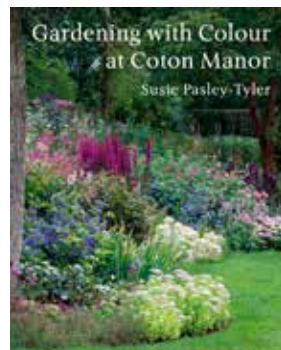

Owner and hands-on gardener Susie Pasley-Tyler charts how her passion for gardening developed and imparts the knowledge learnt, mistakes made and above all the sheer delight to be gained from this creative and restorative pastime.

Occupying a hillside position extending down from the seventeenth-century manor house, the 10-acre garden delights plant enthusiasts with its luxuriant borders providing colour and interest throughout the seasons, while all visitors enjoy its charm and tranquil atmosphere. Beyond the garden is a magical 5-acre bluebell wood and exuberant 3-acre wildflower meadow.

The author describes in detail how the garden has evolved since she and her husband, Ian, inherited the estate over thirty years ago, and her thinking behind its many and varied sites. Experienced and novice gardeners alike will be encouraged and enlightened by her account of being at the helm of one of the finest gardens in England.

CAROLYN DUNSTER

How to grow and harvest an abundant supply of edible ingredients from your garden

Flowers have probably been used in cooking for as long as people have been preparing and flavouring food. In China cooks were experimenting with chive flowers in 3000 BC and the Romans frequently added blooms to their dishes. Today flowers are often seen as an exotic extra employed only by professional chefs. Whilst we are all taking a greater interest in the provenance of our food, adding more plant-based ingredients to our diets, experimenting with growing our own vegetables and eating to follow the seasons, edible flowers remain a bit of an unknown quantity.

A Floral Feast demystifies the idea of eating flowers and introduces readers to a whole range of blooms, leaves, flowering herbs and edible seeds that can be home-grown and used in a new way – by adding them to food. From drying hibiscus petals to concocting a soothing tisane, harvesting nigella seeds to use in savoury biscuits, or baking a lemon-scented pelargonium cake, garden-grown flowers make wonderful ingredients – and align directly with the important current message of seasonal, sustainable growing.

As edible flowers are difficult to source, Dunster shows how to grow an abundant supply of edible flowers to guarantee a regular and plentiful supply of chemical-free ingredients. *A Floral Feast* covers harvesting, drying and preserving techniques, and a wide range of culinary uses and techniques.

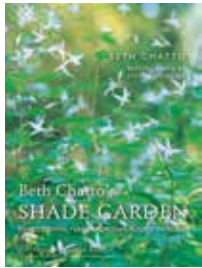
